

Year 7 Catch - Up Funding Impact Statement 2015 - 2016

The Year 7 Catch Up Funding is a government initiative that provides additional funding designed to target resources on those students who have not achieved level 4 or above in Reading and/or Maths. It is estimated that the Department for Education (DfE) provides us with an additional £500 per student so that we can deliver extra support to help these students to "catch up."

In 2015 to 2016 we received £6500

Details of how Priory Woods School used this funding to support these students and increase their successes are outlined below

Initiative	Strategy	Impact
* Communication products to assist with the Sensory Integration approach.	Early year's sensory equipment was purchased to develop student's interaction and communication.	3 students who access sensory learning have made expected progress with 1 student exceeding expectations.
* Numicon Maths resources.	Use of Numicon resource to develop pupils understanding of the connections between numbers	8 students have made expected progress with 1 student requiring further Maths intervention this year.
* Age appropriate reading schemes for year 7 pupils and Sensory Reading Sacks.	A number of reading schemes have been introduced to meet the different levels of students with focus on age appropriateness. Sensory reading sacks are available for use with lower ability groups.	Reading results - 4 students made 3, 2, 6 & 7 months progress 2 students remained at the same level
