




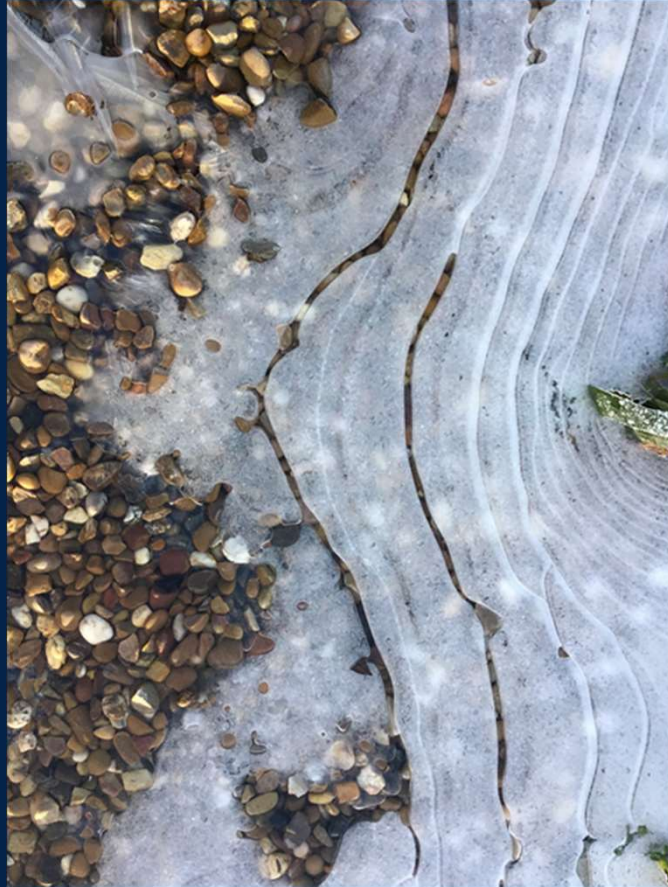
CREATING FROSTY IMAGES
