



## Red-eyed tree frog

Red-eyed tree frog is a species that inhabits rainforests. These frogs are very good jumpers, have sticky toe pads and blend perfectly in green foliage. The red-eyed tree frog has bright green body with large red eyes that usually bulge out.

### Let's make our own red-eye tree frog

#### You will need

- A paper plate
- Green paint or pencils
- Red and green card
- Scissors and ruler
- Black pen
- Glue



#### Instructions

1. Fold your paper plate in half.
2. Using green paint or pencil to colour your plate inside and out, and leave to dry.
3. Cut 4 strips of green card 2cm wide and 10cm long.
4. Using your glue to attach your legs to the frog's body.
5. Cut 2 red eyes for your frog and a red tongue.
6. Using glue attach your eyes and tongue to the body of your frog.
7. All finished your own red-eyed tree frog.



## Instructions

1. Fold your paper plate in half.



2. Using green paint or pencil to colour your plate inside and out, and leave to dry.



3. Cut 4 strips of green card 2cm wide and 10cm long.



4. Using your glue to attach your legs to the frog's body.



5. Cut 2 red eyes for your frog and a red tongue.



6. Using glue attach your eyes and tongue to the body of your frog.
