

How to play Kim's Game.



One of the pupil's favourite games in the classroom is Kim's Game. This is a memory game which helps with thinking and communication skills but is great fun!

To play you will need -

A table top or a tray,

A selection of items from around the house e.g. scissors, hairbrush, sock,

A blanket or tea towel to cover the tray.

Instructions -

Put the selection of objects, no more than 10, onto the tray and talk about each object and check each player knows what they are.

Give yourself chance to look at the tray and then cover it up with the tea towel or blanket. One player then gets to secretly take one object away.

Removing the tea towel or blanket see if the others can identify which item has been taken away.

Repeat as many times as you wish.
